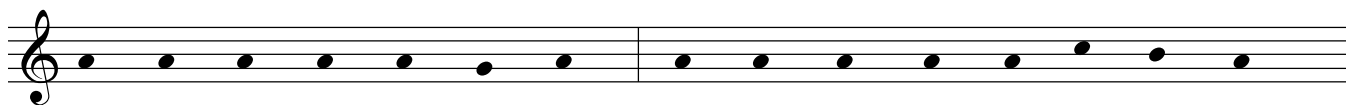


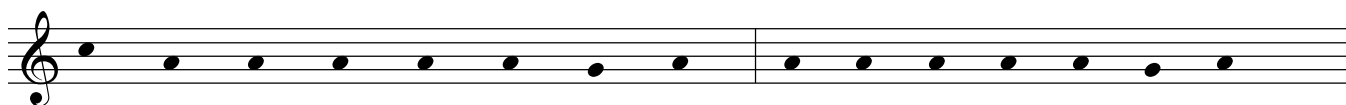
EASTER GOSPEL: Mark 16:1-8



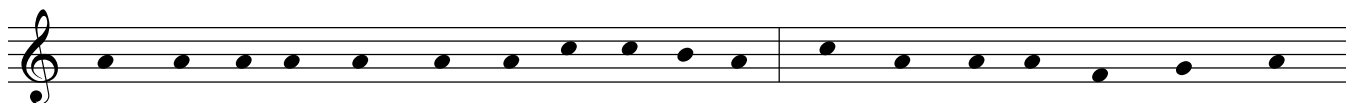
Now when the Sab-bath was past, Mar-y Mag-da-lene, Mar-y the mo-ther of James,



and Sa - lo - me bought spi - ces, that they might come and a - noint Him.



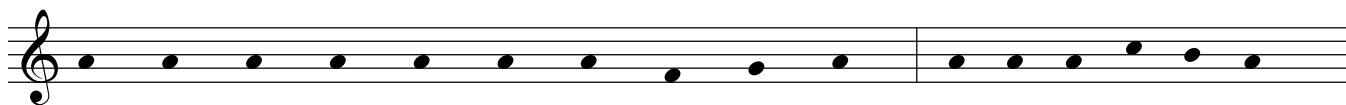
And very ear - ly in the morn - ing, on the first day of the week,



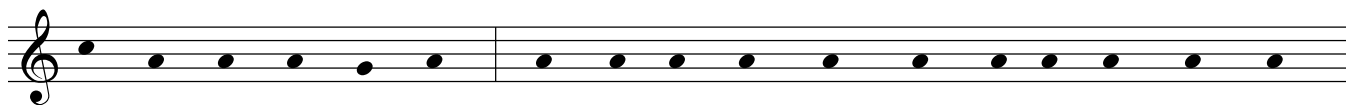
they came to the tomb when the sun had ris-en. And they said a - mong them-selves,




“Who will roll a-way the stone from the door of the tomb for us?” But when they looked up,

And en - ter - ing the tomb, they saw a young man clothed in a long white robe




sit - ting on the right side; and they were a-larmed. But he said to them,




“Do not be a-larmed. You seek Je-sus of Na-za-reth, who was cru - ci-fied.




He is ri-sen! He is not here. See the place where they laid Him. But go your way,
